Registration/check in will be from 7:30 to 8:30

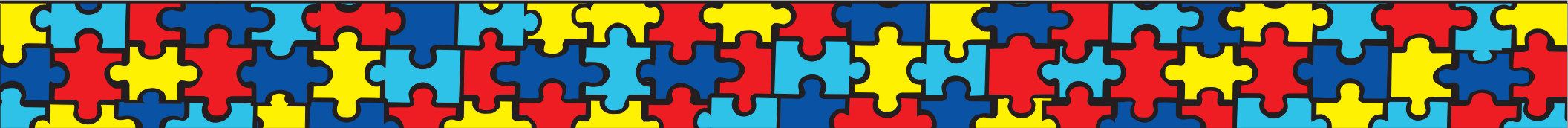
The 2.5 mile walk will start promptly at 8:30 on Saturday, September 17, 2011

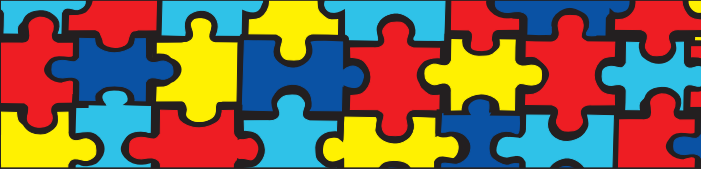

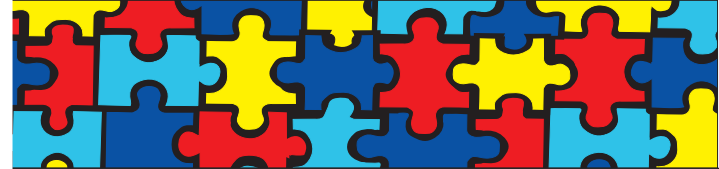
On average, there is \$90 billion spent per year on Autism.
